JAI AGNISH, BEN AND VESPER, LENNY SMITH (Thursday) A night in Brooklyn with three underground songwriters from New Jersey. Mr. Agnish, an accomplice of Sufjan Stevens and a sincere indie-rock Christian, sings guilelessly about his faith (he gives a “thumbs-up to Jesus”) in songs that join acoustic folk with jerky, silly electronics. The male-female duo Ben and Vesper play droopy, forlorn acoustic ballads, and the gospel-folk singer Lenny Smith might be called the father of the scene: his son is Daniel Smith, leader of the perhaps-sincere, perhaps-mocking Christian band Danielson Famile.
